

## ACTIVITY 5: SNAP!

Snap is a common card game played across the world. Traditionally when the cards turned over match 'Snap' is called and if correct the caller collects all the cards. Here are some alternatives. The object of the game is to win all the cards in the deck.

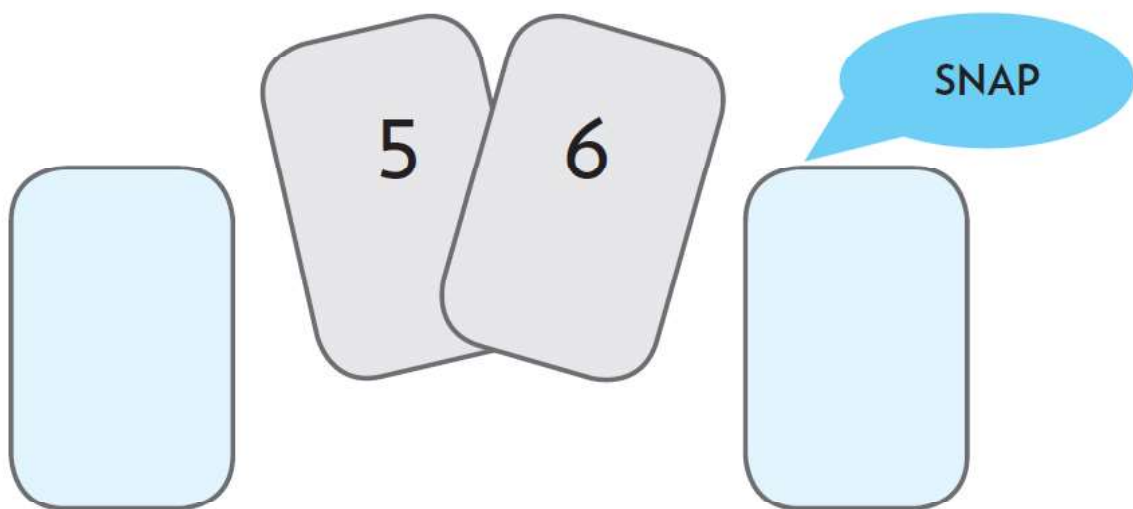
**Materials:**

Deck of cards  
(Picture cards removed)

Aces represent 1

**Players:** 2

- Call "Snap' when the difference between the cards is one
- Call 'Snap' when one card is a multiple of the other, e.g. 2 and 6 or 3 and 9
