## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

**We're still wearing masks!** While we understand that the decision to relax rules on mask wearing in many indoor venues was one that was a relief to many as we try to return to a (Covid) normal existence, schools are still deemed one of the more susceptible environments, so if our students in grades 3 - 6 and all the staff can manage it, we know our parents and carers can slip on a mask when attending the office.

**Please stop at the office** - Our school office can be busy at times, we hope you understand that any wait is unintended, as providing direct support to our families is an important part of our role. If entering any school buildings, parents and carers **MUST** wear a mask and **FIRST** attend the office and seek approval, as schools are still places proving to be subject to the effects of Covid transmission.

**Collecting your child early** - If you arrive at the office to collect your child during the school day for an appointment, it helps if your child and their teacher are aware your child is being picked up and at what time. For everyone's benefit, please try to avoid collecting your child during recess (11.00 - 11.30 am), or lunch play (1.30 - 2.30 pm), as it can be difficult to locate students in the busy yard at these times. Sometimes, (particularly prior to public holidays - like Friday) it can be quite disruptive, so please take note of the above information. We do have a concern with parents collecting students in the last half hour or so of a school day in order to beat the rush. This practice takes our office team a lot of time and is very disruptive to classes.
